

EARTH – HOURS OBSERVANCE AT BBIAP ISLAMABAD

BBIAP Islamabad has observed the Earth Hour at the Airport. 50 Percent (non Operational) lights were switched off from 8:30 pm till 9:30 pm on Saturday, 28th March, 2015. The Objective of this Exercise was to encourage people to consume minimum amount of Energy resources where necessary and to Save Energy for the future generations. However, all operational area lights were on.

CAA observed Earth Hour regularly in collaboration with World Wildlife Fund (WWF) since 2010.
